STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Premier-Pabst Corporation, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, located and doing business at Peoria Heights, Illinois, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for BEER AND ALE, in Class 48, Malt beverages and liquors, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended.

The trade-mark has been continuously used and applied to said goods in applicant's business since August 11, 1935.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the goods by printing lithographing, or impressing

the same directly upon the goods, by means of labels affixed to the goods, and in divers other ways.
